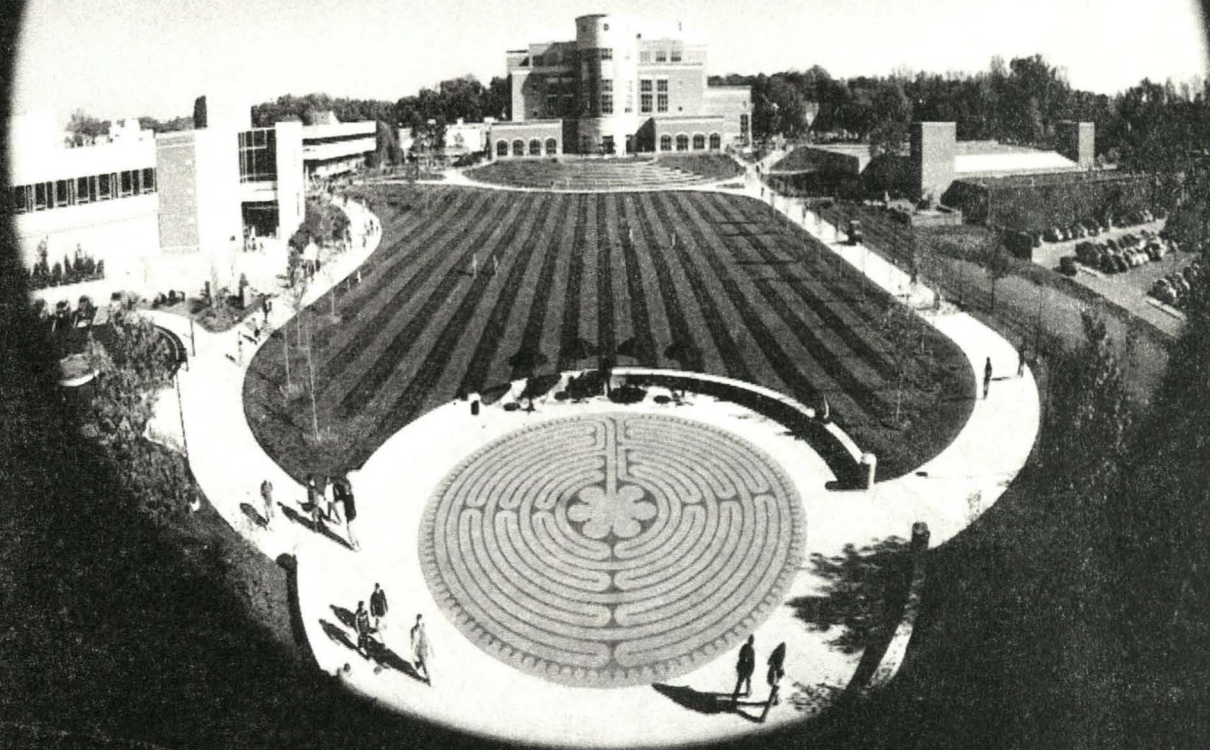

EDITOR'S NOTE

PURPOSE: As a continuation to the 2006 and 2007 *Faculty & Staff Scholarly and Creative Works*, this is the second compilation of the annual publication printed to recognize the outstanding accomplishments of the faculty at USI. We will continue recognizing these achievements in a yearly report of faculty works, which will be merged into a single compilation every ten years for use in the reaccreditation process.

INFORMATION COLLECTED: The information in this report was supplied by colleges based on individual faculty members' annual evaluations. Corrections and additional entries were provided by individual staff and faculty members after the release of two drafts.

WHAT IS INCLUDED: This report is limited to scholarly and creative works completed in the calendar year 2007. In keeping with USI's broad definition of scholarly and creative works, the report includes listings of books, book chapters, book and journal reviews, encyclopedia entries, published articles (i.e. newspaper, magazine, journal, website, etc.), conference presentations, performances, exhibits, patents (issued date in 2008), and projects. The name of the USI producer of each work is bolded, and when there are multiple USI authors in different departments the entry has been duplicated under each name. Entries, in which there are multiple USI authors in the same department, are alphabetized under the first name appearing in the entry. Grants are listed together in a separate section following the college listings.

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED: While this is an inclusive list, it does not include many aspects of professional activities that are nevertheless valued and rewarded at USI. This report does not, for example, include service activities, leadership roles, guest lectures, or organizing, facilitating, moderating or participating in workshops or conferences, regardless of whether or not such roles were the result of invitations. No items that are forthcoming or accepted for publication or presentation are included; such items will be included in the report for the year in which they are published or presented.

Local presentations and publications are of enormous service to the university and region; however, since they are generally not included in the larger academic understanding of scholarship they have not been collected for this report. Specifically, this report will not include presentations at college colloquia or the RISC Showcase; information regarding participation in events of that nature will be documented elsewhere for accreditation. Similarly, we have not collected articles in local publications such as *The Evansville Business Journal*. It is important to note that the determination of whether or not an entry is considered "scholarship" is up to the colleges; inclusion in this report has no bearing on that determination.

FORMAT: This publication implements a consistent formatting and documentation style modeled after *The Chicago Manual of Style*, which is the most common citation style for interdisciplinary bibliographies.

ARCHIVE OF WORKS: Rice Library maintains an archive of faculty publications and presentations. Copies of your work submitted to Rice Library will be gratefully received and cataloged.
